



Isles Farm Woodland Design - November 2025 V6

- Planting land (~133ha)
- ◆ Proposed private bridges at several key locations
- All weather management access
- Landscape trail/ light management access
- Predominantly broadleaved planting (43ha, 32%, 107,500 trees) including existing hedgerows allowed to grow out.
- Predominantly mixed conifer planting (31ha, 23%, 77,500 trees), the Black Forest; generally in areas of 'contained' landscape adjacent to existing dense or mixed woodland.
- Open ground integral to the woodland areas (21.5ha, 16%) managed primarily by mechanical means
- Topographic clumps (<1ha) Atlas cedar south of Coker Court Park, Scots pine north of Coker Wood. Beech and Scots pine between two valleys
- Agroforestry areas (36ha, 27%) managed by extensive grazing by cattle in parkland areas sheep in orchards and Arcadian agroforestry. Existing roadside hedges to be kept trimmed. Also includes widely-spaced (8-13m) orchard, parkland and agroforestry planting (up to 20% ground cover, 7-9ha, <10,000 trees) including Somerset varieties of fruit, walnut, cricket-bat willow, and one avenue of oaks.
